



Real Recovery Podcast Inc.

Article of Association

Article I: Name

The name of the organization is The Real Recovery Podcast, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "the Organization")

Article II: Purpose

The Organization is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and social welfare purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Specifically, the organization aims to:

1. Provide education to those affected by addiction.
2. Educate the public on addiction and recovery.
3. Promote social welfare by advocating for supportive environments.
4. Engage in community-benefiting initiatives.

In furtherance of these purposes, the organization may make distributions to other organizations that qualify as exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article III: Board of Directors

The organization shall be governed by a Board of Directors consisting of three members: a President, a Secretary, and a Treasurer. These officers shall have the authority and responsibilities as defined in the bylaws.

Article IV: Governance and Meetings

1. **Board Meetings:** Regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held at least quarterly, with special meetings called as needed. Notice of meetings shall be given at least seven days in advance.
2. **Quorum:** A majority of the board members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
3. **Voting:** Each director shall have one vote. Decisions shall be made by a majority vote of the directors present at a meeting where a quorum is present.



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Article V: Officers and Duties

1. **President:** The President shall preside over all meetings, oversee the organization's activities, and ensure compliance with the board's policies and procedures.
2. **Secretary:** The Secretary shall keep accurate records of all board meetings, manage official correspondence, and maintain the organization's records.
3. **Treasurer:** The Treasurer oversees the organization's financial matters, maintains accurate financial records, and provides financial reports at each board meeting.

Article VI: Compensation

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II.

Article VII: Fiscal Year

The fiscal year of the organization shall end on the last day of December.

Article VIII: Amendments

These articles of association may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors, provided that written notice of the proposed amendment is given to all board members at least ten days prior to the meeting.

Article IX: Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
